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Major Achievements

Land Allocations:

- » A total of 14147 PVTG HH received FRA Titles with 26414 acres of land.
- » A total of 9436 PVTG HHs received homestead land with 452 acres of land.
- » Similarly, 6516 PVTG HHs received agricultural land with 4805 acres of land.

Agriculture:

- » 24850 no of farmers supported under different agricultural and horticulture crop production under cereal, pulses, oil seed and vegetable cultivation.
- » 20,245 PVTG HH supported with kitchen Garden.
- » 17 nos. of Model Nursery @ Rs. 10 lakh each and 28 nos. of small nursery / working capital for nursery @ Rs.50,000 each have been established

AIC Cluster:

- » 303 no of agriculture intensification cluster promoted benefiting 3423 households in 6305ac.
- » 242 no. of irrigation structures promoted in 202 clusters.

PVTG Empowerment Fund(PEF):



- » 110 Maternal Spot Feeding Centres are operational benefitting 880 pregnant and lactating mothers.
- » 105 Spot Feeding centres are operational benefitting 1053 3 to 6 years children

Livestock

- » 10000 PVTG households have been supported with backyard poultry (25+25 birds) in convergency with FARD.
- » 3527 PVTG households have been supported with back-



- » 584 PVTG SHGs have been supported with 30 +2 goatery in convergence with F&ARD.
- » 314 nos. of Poultry unit (100 bird per unit) given.
- 570 nos. of HH given Goatary Unit (5+1).

Government of Odisha in partnership with International Fund for Agriculture Development (IFAD) has taken up "Odisha PVTG Empowerment & Livelihoods Improvement Programme" (OPELIP) in the year 2016–17 for livelihoods improvement of 13 Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTG) in the State of Odisha.

The programme is being implemented through 17 Micro Project Agencies in 12 districts, covering 1125 villages of 89 Gram Panchayats. The programme targets to cover 96651 households during 8-year programme period.

- Drudgery reduction interventions


Outcomes:
